Things to Note about the Centurion:

- His incredible kindness and love.
- His incredible humility.
- His sense of sin.
- His incredible faith.



Things to Note about the Widow & Son:

- Jesus heals out of compassion.
- The faith of those involved is not revealed to us.
- Don't grumble when God blesses others you see as undeserving.



John's Disciples Examine Jesus

- John wants his followers to transition to Jesus.
- They need to believe on their own.
- They witness Jesus:
 - Curing diseases and sickness.
 - Exorcising evil spirits.
 - Giving sight to the blind.

- Cleansing those with leprosy.
- Making the deaf hear.
- Raising the dead.
- Proclaiming the good news to the poor.
- Jesus tells them to report what they have witnessed.

When we share with others what we've witnessed God doing, our own faith grows.

Things to Note about John

- He is not wavering like a reed in the wind.
- He is not a fickle courtier.
- He is more than a prophet because he is the subject of prophecy himself.
- He is the greatest Old Testament prophet, under the Old Covenant, prior to the cross and New Covenant.

True wisdom shows itself in the actions of John and Jesus, not in their outward appearance of austerity or conviviality.



Things to Note about Simon

- He's a reluctant host who provides:
 - No kiss of greeting.
 - No water.
 - No oil.



Things to Note about the Woman

- She was reputed to be "sinful."
- She witnessed Jesus' humiliation at the hands of Simon and the other Pharisees.
- She washed his feet with tears, kissed them and anointed them with perfume.
- She had faith that she was forgiven.
- Her gratitude for forgiveness was shown by her acts of extravagant love.

More Things to Note about Simon

- He's a reluctant host who provides:

- He sees himself as upstanding, respectable, with few transgressions.
- He is cold, selfish and has little love.
- He has no sense of his debt of sin.
