Trust and Obey



Prayer—Luke 11:1-13

- A pattern, not a formula
- Persistence
- Promised provision



Prayer—the pattern

- Papa—relationship
- Praise
- Petition

```
greatest desire
specific needs—daily food; forgiveness;
    protection
```



Prayer—persistence

Persistence – "boldness" or "shamelessness" won't take "no" for an answer



Prayer—the promised provision

- A ask (not "beg"). Take needs to the Father.
- S seek. Ask and take action.
- K knock. Ask + action + persistence.

The promise—we will receive what we need; we will find what we need; the door will be opened.

Power and Light—Luke 11:14-36

Jesus' power and authority are from God; He will defeat Satan; He has brought God's Kingdom.

"If you're not for Me, you are against Me."

"See to it"—light, not darkness, in our hearts



The Heart—Luke 11:37-53

- External actions vs. internal attitudes
- "Woes" are gracious warnings to save
- Sins of greed and pride
- Sins of arrogance, rejection of the Word, causing others to stumble
- The sin of hypocrisy
