## **BE** Humble

#### Pharisee

- Stood by himself (on purpose)
- Prayer showed:
  - Did not think highly of others
  - Proclaiming list of good deeds
  - A self-righteous heart

#### Tax Collector

- Stood at a distance (out of shame)
- Prayer showed:
  - Did not think highly of self
  - Proclaiming need for mercy
  - A broken, desperate heart

### Pride vs. Humility

"Attitude" Check: Would you rather ....

Be respected and embraced by fellow man at the risk of throwing away God? OR

Risk being thrown away by man, and embraced by God?

\* TRUST that God will care for you


2. Rich Man vv. 18-30

#### "Attitude" Check:

- ~ Are you willing to return your paddle to God?
- ~ What do I do when God's answer is not what I want to hear? Do I walk away sad, trusting my way is better - or do I trust that God's answer is the BEST answer?

# BE Persistent (in Prayer)

#### <u>Widow</u>

- Stranger to Judge; no relationship
- No access to Judge; No one to stand up for her in court

#### <u>Us</u>

- Children of God & God cares for His children (Luke 11:13)
- Open access into God's presence, may come to Him anytime for help (Eph. 2:18, 3:12; Heb. 4:14-16, 10:19-22)
   Spirit intercedes for us when needed (Romans 8:26-27)

#### <u>Judge</u>

 Self-centered Corrupt

#### <u>God</u>

Compassionate (Psalm 145:8)
 Just (Deuteronomy 32:4)
 Merciful (Ephesians 2:4-5)





# Common Roadblocks to Prayer

- 1. Do my prayers matter?
- 2. I don't feel like God is answering my prayers.
- 3. I don't feel a personal connection to God when I pray.

### Prescriptions for Prayer:

- 1. Think of two examples of answered prayer in your own life.
  - -One being a time God's answer "looked" like what you expected
  - -One being a time God's answer "looked" different than what you expected.
