Pause for thought: What difference does it make to you in your daily life that Jesus is alive?



The Final Rebuttal—Luke 20:41-44

Jesus is both son of and Lord of David.

Pause for thought: Which attributes of Christ attract you? Which repel you? Ponder your personal need for the cross during Lent.



The Summary Conclusion—Luke 20:45-21:4

Pause for thought: If people could only get to know Jesus through the way we live, what conclusions would they reach about Him?
