

Romans 8:12-17

When we live by the Spirit:

- 1. We "put to death the misdeeds of the body."
- 2. We become aware of and assured of our new identity in Christ.



Privileges of Being in Christ's Family Gifts of the Spirit:

- 1. We are led by the Spirit.
- We are given the Spirit of Sonship—we have a different relationship with the Father than before. We are secure.
- 3. We have authority as sons, not slaves. We can live with confidence and poise.
- 4. We can cry "Abba!"—intimacy
- 5. We are assured that we are God's children.
- We are heirs.
- 7. We will be disciplined as children of God.
- 8. We will bear the family likeness—suffering.



Approach life in two ways:

1. by the Spirit that makes us slaves again to fear.

OR

2. by the Spirit of Sonship.
