<p><b>Romans 12:9-21</b></p> <p><b>Love in Action</b></p> <p><sup>9</sup> Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. <sup>10</sup> Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves. <sup>11</sup> Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. <sup>12</sup> Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. <sup>13</sup> Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality.</p> <p><sup>14</sup> Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. <sup>15</sup> Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn. <sup>16</sup> Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position.<sup>[c]</sup> Do not be conceited.</p> <p><sup>17</sup> Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. <sup>18</sup> If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. <sup>19</sup> Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay,"<sup>[d]</sup> says the Lord. <sup>20</sup> On the contrary:</p> <p>"If your enemy is hungry, feed him;            if he is thirsty, give him something to drink.          In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head."<sup>[e]</sup></p> <p><sup>21</sup> Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.</p>
