Review of Romans

- All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. (We can't get ourselves out of the mess.)
- God demonstrates His own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- We are saved by grace through faith in God's Son. (There is no condemnation for those in Christ.)
- We are dead to sin but alive to God in Christ.
- We have been raised to new life in Christ.
- We have received the Spirit of sonship.

Review of Romans

- We are God's children, co-heirs with Christ.
- The Spirit intercedes for us.
- In all things God works for the good of those who love Him and are called according to His purpose.
- We are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.
- Nothing can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus, our Lord.



Review of Romans

- If you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ... Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.
- Offer your bodies as living sacrifices.
- Be transformed by the renewing of your mind.
- We are one body.
- Love one another.
- Whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord.
