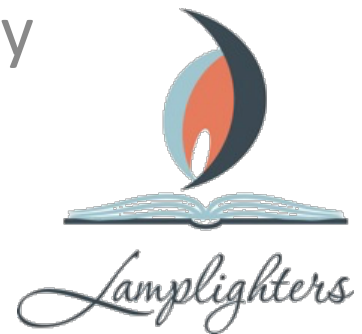

- IS: messy, includes difficult stories, personal, unique to you!

Start with:

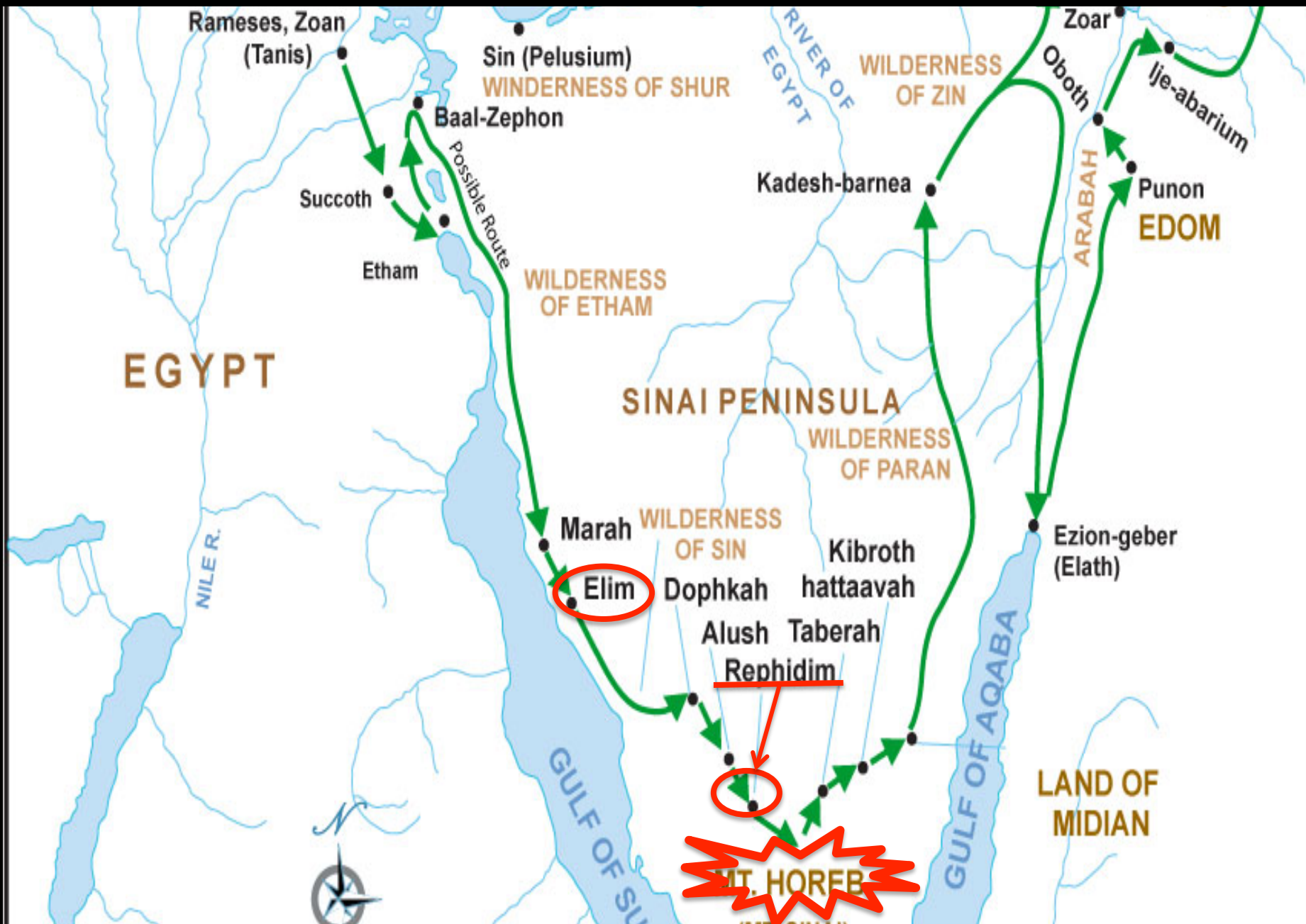
- Your earliest memory of some place that made you feel loved and safe

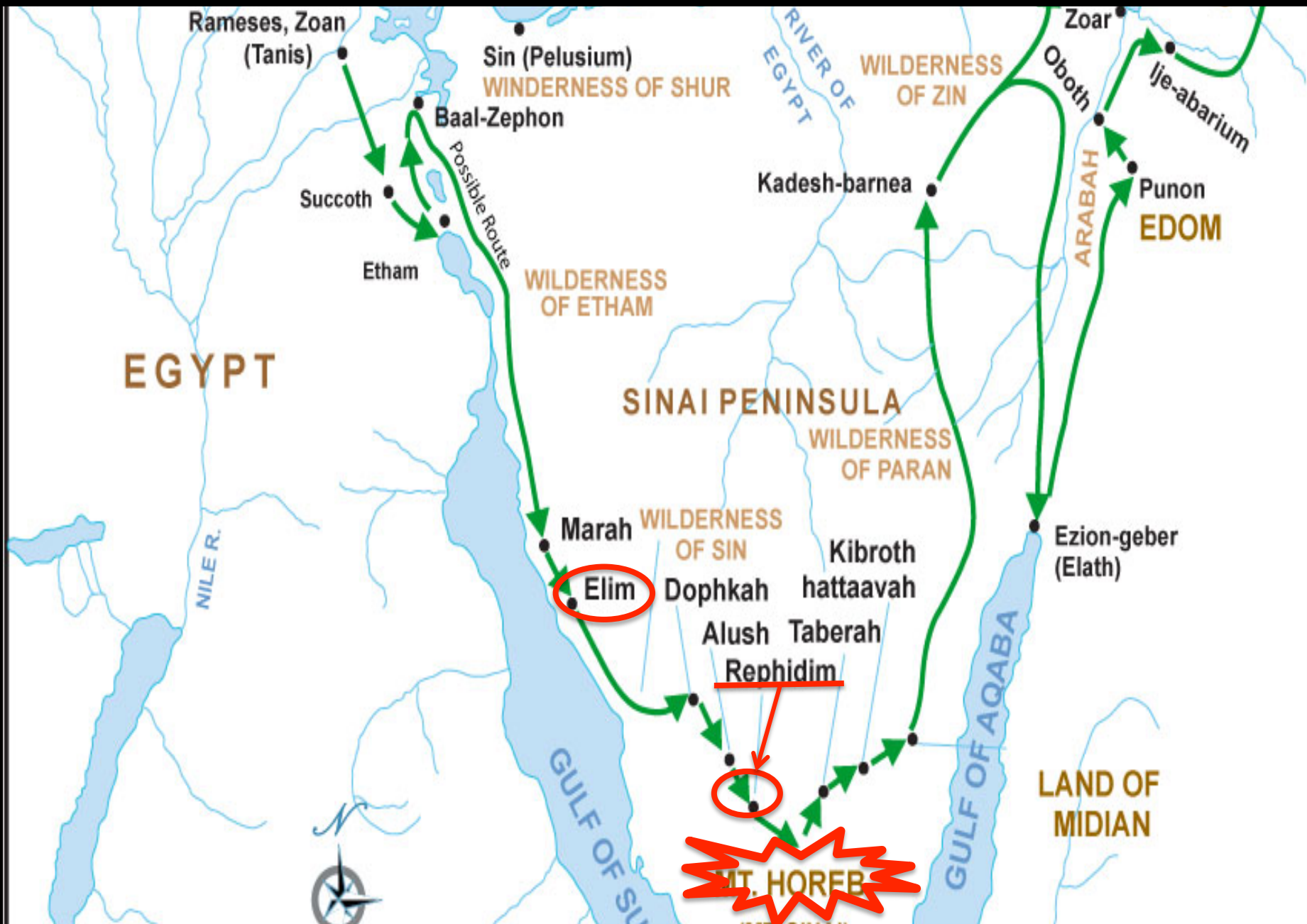


Murmuring and Manna—Exodus 16

Water and Warfare—Exodus 17

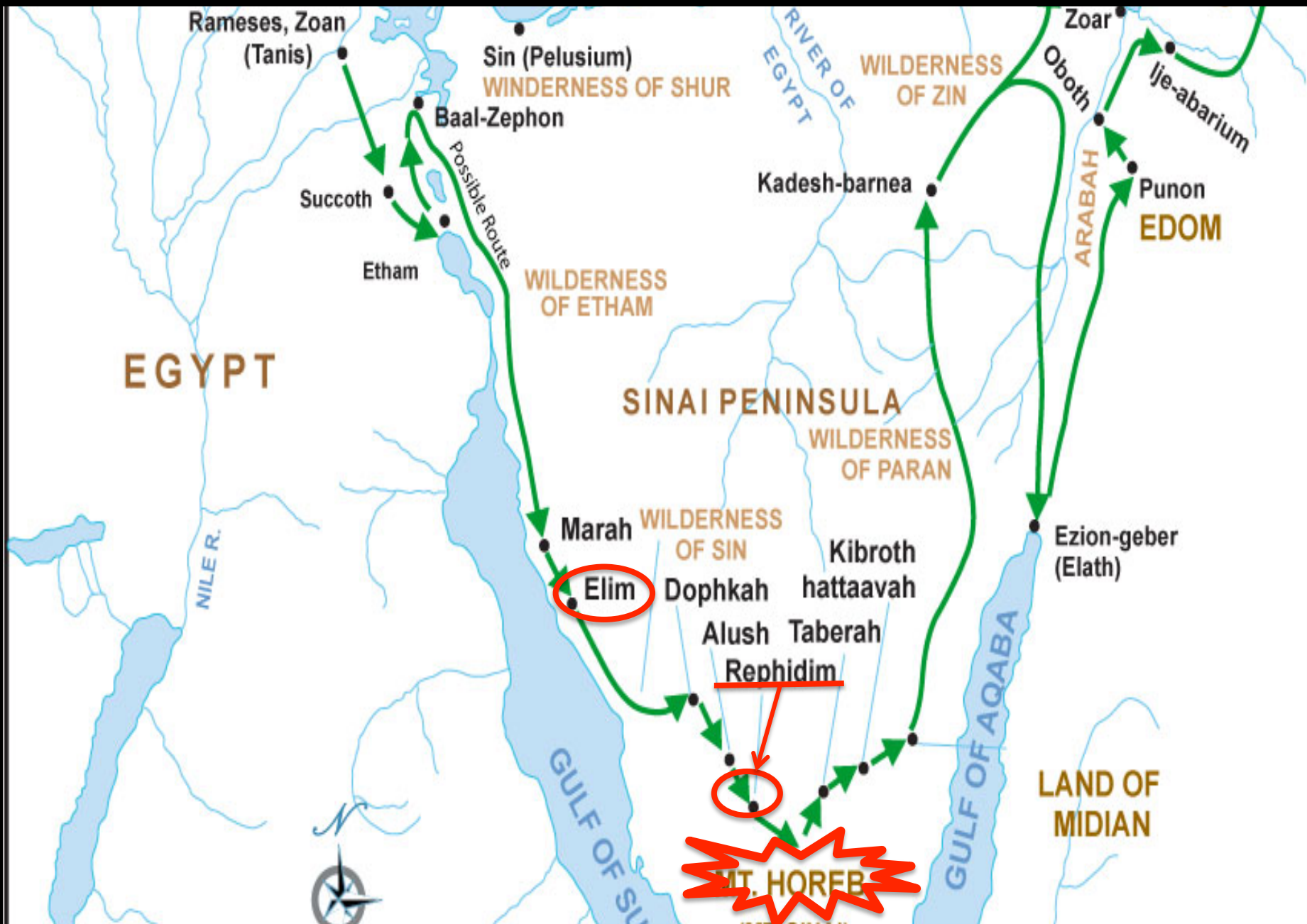
Jehovah-shammah—the God who is with them
