Pictures of Salvation

Bronze Altar—place of sacrifice, bronze is a symbol of sin, perpetual fire symbolizes God's judgement against sin

Jesus died on an altar; it was called the cross.

Bronze Laver—symbolizes cleansing from sin Jesus died to wash away our sins.

Altar of Incense—represents intercession/prayer Jesus intercedes for us.

Table of Bread and Presence—God provides daily

Jesus is the Bread of Life

Lampstand—provided light for the priests

Jesus is the light of the world

Veil—separates the Holy of Holies, symbolizes the flesh of Jesus' body When Jesus dies on the cross, the veil was torn in two.

Ark and the Mercy Seat—where God meets with men.
