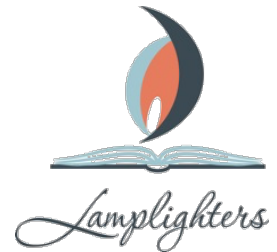

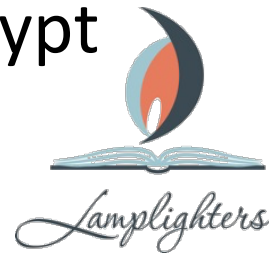

8. Locust—Seth, god of the storm and disorder
9. Darkness—Ra, the sun god
10. Firstborn—Pharaoh, Ultimate power in Egypt
