 - (Mt. 7:21-23)
- Second invitation to build our lives upon hearing and living out Jesus' words
 - (Mt. 7:24-27)

First Invitation – To Follow Jesus



"Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it."

Mt. 7:13-14

First warning: "Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves." (Mt. 7:15)






Second Warning: False disciples

- First deception thinking that saying the right words is all one needs to do to enter the kingdom of heaven – Mt. 7:21
- Second deception thinking that attributing God's name to one's own works and actions is all one needs to do to enter the kingdom of heaven – Mt. 7:22-23

Second Invitation – To Build Our Lives Upon Hearing and Living Out Jesus' Words

- But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on the sand. (Mt. 7:26)
