<p><b>Genesis 1:1-2, 26</b>  <sup>1</sup> In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup> Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.  <sup>26</sup> Then God said, “Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness, so that they may rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, over the livestock and all the wild animals, and over all the creatures that move along the ground.”</p> <p><b>Luke 10:21-22</b>  <sup>21</sup> At that time Jesus, full of joy through the Holy Spirit, said, “I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children. Yes, Father, for this is what you were pleased to do.  <sup>22</sup> “All things have been committed to me by my Father. No one knows who the Son is except the Father, and no one knows who the Father is except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.”</p> <p><b>Matthew 28:19-20</b>  <sup>19</sup> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”</p> <p><b>2 Corinthians 13:14</b>  <sup>14</sup> May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.</p>

<p><b>Psalm 139:7-8</b></p> <p><sup>7</sup> Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence?</p> <p><sup>8</sup> If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there.</p> <p><b>Zechariah 4:6</b></p> <p><sup>6</sup> So he said to me, “This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: ‘Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,’ says the LORD Almighty.</p> <p><b>John 14:16-17</b></p> <p><sup>16</sup> And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— <sup>17</sup> the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be <sup>a</sup> in you.</p> <p><b>Romans 8:27</b></p> <p><sup>27</sup> And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God’s people in accordance with the will of God.</p> <p><b>1 Corinthians 2:9-10</b></p> <p><sup>9</sup> However, as it is written: “What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived”<sup>b</sup>— the things God has prepared for those who love him—</p> <p><sup>10</sup> these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit. <p><b>1 Corinthians 12:4-6, 11</b></p> <p><sup>4</sup> There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. <sup>5</sup> There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. <sup>6</sup> There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.</p> <p><sup>11</sup> All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he distributes them to each one, just as he determines.</p> <p><b>Ephesians 4:30</b></p> <p><sup>30</sup> And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.</p>
